Competition terms and conditions:

The competition takes place in two stages:

- Preliminary rounds: They take place in different cities in France or MP4 video recordings may be sent.
- The final takes place in Paris.

Schedule of preliminary rounds for the following cities:

Registration deadline: three weeks before the date of the events

Candidates who are unable to travel to the above-mentioned cities may still participate in the preliminary round by sending a video recording of the chosen piece to the competition headquarters before the **05th May 2024**.

-Junior Section : 25th May 2024 - PARIS

-Artistic section : 26th May 2024 - PARIS

COMPETITION RULES

The CIP is open to all pianists, without age limits

1. Preliminary round:

The preliminary rounds will take place in different cities in France.

Candidates unable to attend in the preliminary cities may still participate in the rounds by sending the **video recording** by email.

Only candidates who have performed the pieces from memory will be able to participate in the Finals.

For the candidates presenting the 4 Hands, presenting from memory is not mandatory for the preliminary rounds and the Finals.

In the "Artistic" section, the preliminary rounds will be done only by video recording.

2. Finals in Paris:

No additional registration fees

The selected candidates will present from memory (except for the 4 hands) the same piece as that chosen for the preliminaries. The members of the jury board will be communicated on the day of the Finals.

The jury reserves the right not to distribute all the awards and to stop the candidate when he considers having sufficient information to assign a score. **Jury decisions are final.**

The first-place prize of the CIP, proposed by the president must be accepted by the majority of the members of the Jury. In the event of a tie, the prize will be divided between the two candidates. In the 4 Hands piano discipline, any prizes will be shared between the two partners.

3. Closing of registration:

The candidates who participate in the competition by video recording must send the video recording with registration form three weeks before the date in the chosen city, or no later than **05/ May/2024**.

THE REGISTRATION FEES WILL IN NO CASE BE REFUNDED.

Travel and accommodation expenses are the responsibility of the candidate.
In the event of a litigation, only the French text of the competition rules will be taken into consideration.

Preliminary round: At the end of the preliminary round, the candidates will receive a certificate of participation via the internet mentioning their regional award:

1st Place "Finalist", 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th place or Encouragement.

Only candidates who have obtained the 1st Place "Finalist" award may participate in the Finals in Paris.

Finals: Results to be announced in Paris the 3rd and 4th of June 2023, after the finals.

If you are unable to attend the awards ceremony at the end of the Final, please provide us with a 22.5 x 32.5 envelope with the last name, first name and address of the candidate, pre-stamped at the current rate (100g). Please provide this envelope on the day of the Final, at the competition reception.

The first place of the CIP will receive a reward and diploma. The other places will receive a diploma. (See the list below).
